



"Come as You Are, Stay in Your Car" Summer Drive-In Concert

Where? 9255 Ogallala Road, Longmont. Directions from Broomfield – Hwy 287 north to Niwot Rd. Turn left on Niwot Rd to the light at 95th St. Turn right on 95th St until you see a flashing 35 mph speed sign and look for Ogallala Rd on your left before the flashing sign. Turn left and drive ½ mile to the Four Crows Farm. Turn right onto the gravel driveway:



How? Tune your FM radio dial to the station posted at the end of the driveway.

Parking? Proceed straight down the driveway to the recently mowed hay field. There will be an emcee on the radio and ushers in yellow vests directing where to park. Stay in a single-file line and drive on the farm access road as much as possible to preserve the hay crop in the field. Park at least 6 feet from the nearest car. Stay in your car!

Bathroom? Please take care of this business before you come. For emergencies, there is a bathroom in the barn behind the house, which can be accessed on foot down the concrete driveway. Sanitation products will be available, but there will be no cleaning between visits. If you leave your car, please wear a mask.

How to show your appreciation in your car? Honk your horn!! The musicians will thank you as it's weird to be playing to windshields.

How to Exit? Please be patient. It will be conducted single file, last in, first out. The emcee and ushers in yellow vests will assist you, so please listen to your radio. The Broomfield Symphony Orchestra is extremely grateful for the donation of the use of this private property. Parking is on a hay crop so please be respectful and minimize driving on the field, by using the access road and driveway as much as possible. If you need to leave before the end of the concert, please proceed to the access road or the driveway with as little driving on the hay as possible. Thank you!
